Criteria

To be considered for nominations, the respected candidate must have worked in their area of expertise for 3 months and have made a significant contribution to the service (e.g. implemented changes to improve themselves and/or the workplace or reached significant goals through their education and training). Eligibility

You may nominate yourself or a family member for an award. To be eligible a candidate must:

- Identify as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander
- Be an active employee at the time of nomination
- Have made a significant contribution to their area of expertise within the Gilgandra Community
