Recycling: Help Us, Help You

Your yellow-lidded bin is the recycling bin. In this bin you should place:

- Paper and cardboard, magazines and newspapers,
- Hard plastics – bathroom/laundry/ kitchen products, milk/juice bottles, fruit & vegetable punnets, margarine/ yoghurt/icecream containers.
- Glass – clear, brown, and green,
- Metals – steel cans, aluminum cans, aerosols (empty), foil (balled up), and aluminum foil bake trays (clean).

Your yellow-lidded kerbside recycling bin and yellow recycling bags are hand-sorted by our supported employees from Carlginda. They all live with an intellectual disability, have a whole lot of heart, and love their job, so please only put clean recyclables in your bin/bags!

Don't place anything smaller than a credit card in your recycling. If you want to recycle small items place them in a bigger item made of the same materials. For example place small plastic lids and bread clips into an empty plastic container and place in your recycling when full.

To assist Council in managing our waste, we request that you sort your items before bringing them to the Waste Facility. Unsorted waste attracts a fee.

Recycling tips from our staff

- #1 Empty any food containers
- #2 Clean containers out – give them a real good wash!
- #3 Keep your recycling free – don't tie up in plastic bin liners
- #4 Only place recyclable resources in your recycling bin

Landfill

Your green waste bin is where your rubbish goes to **landfill**. In this bin goes:

- Tissues and used paper towel, nappies, sanitary products and adult incontinence pants
- Food scraps
- Animal waste
- Household items – or if they are in good condition donate to a local charity or the Op Shop
- Styrofoam products



Community Recycling Centre

The Community Recycling Centre (CRC) accepts materials which have the potential to be an environmental or public health risk. They often need special processing before they can be safely recycled.

Resources accepted at the Gilgandra CRC include:

- Batteries
- Oil and water based paints, plus other kinds of paints
- Florescent tubes and globes
- Aerosol cans
- Fire extinguishers
- Gas cylinders
- Motor and cooking oils, plus other oils
- Tyres
- Smoke alarms
- Other hazardous chemicals

Please note: these items are not accepted as part of your recycling bin service or yellow bags. They are only for drop-off at the CRC area of Gilgandra Waste Facility during our opening hours.
